### 2. **WELCOME BY KATHLEEN TAYLOR:**

- a. Kathleen provided parents some reminders:
  - 1) Kick-off the Gold Card Fundraiser.
  - 2) Pride Pack Orders and due date.
  - 3) Reminded parents to review e-mails regarding upcoming events.
  - 4) Minutes of the Parent Meetings will be posted on the CB West Football website to allow those parents who cannot attend the parent meetings.

### 3. **NOTE OF "THANKS" VOLUNTEERISM/SUPPORT OF OUR BUCKS**

- a. Beth Bradley has lead the effort with the Gold Cards. This is something that starts months in advance. Many thanks to Beth!
- b. Tom Ferrentino has done an incredible job at supporting the Gold Outing, working with potential sponsors, working with the team to get raffle items. Many thanks to Tom!
- c. Nancy Cuozzo and Beth Bradley are leading the efforts with our Game Program. A lot of effort and work is involved in getting this up and running. This is important because this is an opportunity for our business in the community to get advertising. As such, we need to get the word out to the community, but parents also have an opportunity to give a message to individual players in the Game Program.

**4. GOLD CARDS**

- a. We are doing some things differently. District is working across all the schools to develop procedures that are consistently implemented.
- b. The Gold Cards provides the holder of the card a discount from many local businesses in the area. As such, this benefits both the local businesses and the team in our fundraising effort.
- c. As a result, this year we are going to issue the Gold Cards at the end of the meeting, we are asking all parents to acknowledge that they have received the Gold Cards and that payment is expected on May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017 during Mini Camp. The Club would like to receive any un-sold Gold Cards back if the player is not able to sell them.
- d. If parents rather give the Parent Club a donation in the amount of \$200 tonight, we will accept that tonight.
- e. Laurie emphasized the importance of having each player sell the Gold Cards as it affects our ability to purchase items for the players.
- f. Kathleen read the different local businesses listed on the Gold Cards and answered questions from the parents.
- g. Coach addressed the parents and said the players should be selling the Gold Cards by May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Players can post the availability on social media. Cards usually go pretty quick so players should get out and sell them.

**5. EVENTS: Coach Cathers.**

- a. Encouraged parents to check the calendar on the website.
- b. On May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017, we have an all-star game at Neshaminy and we have 5 players that played last year and are graduating this year.
- c. Also, at the end of May 2017, we are getting ready for Mini Camp. Equipment distribution will be on May 22, 2017.
- d. Physicals must be completed after June 1, 2017.
- e. Impact testing and concussion on June 6, 2017 and parents will receive an e-mail reminding them of this.
- f. Coach reminded parents to use the Remind app to communicate with him.

6. **GOLF OUTING:** by Mark McCool and Rebecca Shields
- a. Kathleen announced that we've been doing this fundraiser for 30 years. This year is especially important because it honors Coach Pettine, so there are things we are doing differently this year.
  - b. Kathleen also demonstrated the different raffle baskets we had to be filled with donated items from parents.
  - c. Mark told parents that we desperately need the help of volunteer parents to help out with this event. So far, we have 35 golfers signed up. Need help to set up during this event.
  - d. This year, a portion of the proceeds for this event will go to a scholarship for a graduating senior in honor of Coach Pettine.
  - e. We are also having a clothing sale at the Golf Outing and a portion of those sales will also go toward the scholarship.
  - f. Dinner will be for **\$45 per person** if parents do not want to play golf. This event is a good opportunity for parents to socialize with other parents.
  - g. There will also be a silent auction to generate some revenue during this event.
  - h. There's different deadlines for Black and Gold sponsorship levels. May 3<sup>rd</sup> is for the Gold Sponsors and May 8<sup>th</sup> is for the Black sponsors. We are low on sponsorships this year and would appreciate everyone participating in this event to help support the team.
  - i. Rebecca encouraged parents to see her after the meeting to sign up to help with this event.
7. **CAR WASH.** Eileen K. reported. This event will be on Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017, rain date on May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017 at the Dairy Queen in Doylestown.
- a. Parents were encouraged to volunteer to help out with the Car Wash. Looking for 2 parents per 2-hour time slots.
  - b. This benefits our CB West Needy Student Fund. We want to make sure that players participate in this. Players will be working the Car Wash and parents will be supervising the players. There will also be a sign-up sheet in the Weight Room.
  - c. Looking for old towels we can use during the Car Wash.

- d. For parents that are planning on volunteering, Eileen asked that they bring buckets and supplies.
8. **YOUTH CAMP:** On July 10<sup>th</sup> to the 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017, from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- a. Players would be counselors for the younger participants. Coach said he will have a sign-up sheet for the players to volunteer in the Team Room.
  - b. Coach has already sent out e-mails to different organizations to get participants to attend this Youth Camp.
  - c. Players receive community service hours for helping out with this event.
  - d. Freshman do not participate in this Youth Camp because players are too old to participate and too young to help out.
9. **NFL DRAFT:** Coach said he will be taking some players for the Eagles draft day on Friday, April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Upper classmen voted for some seniors to go on stage and participate in this draft event.
10. **PICTURE DAY:** Will be on August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2017, starting at 7:30 a.m.
- a. Pictures for Senior Night will be taken on that day for players and parents on this date.
  - b. Hoping to take the pictures on the field, but may be at an alternate location because field will be under construction.
11. **NEXT MEETING:** Monday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the Team Room.
12. At the conclusion of the Parent Meeting, parents were given an opportunity to pick up the Gold Cards, register if they had not done so already, ask questions to respective Reps., and purchase Spirit Wear at discounted prices.
